TOPIC – NOUN

Defination- A noun is a naming word. It names a place, a person, a thing , an animal or an idea.

There are two types of nouns:

- a. Common Nouns
- b. Proper Nouns

Common Nouns- We use a common noun for any place, person, animal, thing or idea. It begins with a small letter.

Eg- school, boy, cat, bus, love, etc.

Proper Nouns- A proper noun is the special name of a person, a place, a thing or an animal. It begins with Capital letter.

Eg- Raj, Chennai, Mount Abu, etc
