INDEFINITE ARTICLES:-

We use the article a or an before a singular noun. "A" is used when the noun is singular and begins with a consonant sound. "AN" is used when the noun is singular and begins with a vowel sound. A and an are Indefinite Articles.

Examples:

- 1) I can see a giraffe.
- 2) Golu eats an egg everyday.

DEFINITE ARTICLES:-

The word "the" is also an article. It is used before the names of buildings, rivers, seas, oceans, hills, mountains and mountain ranges. It is definite article.
