Articles

INDEFINITE ARTICLES:-

We use the article <u>a</u> or <u>an</u> before a singular noun. "<u>A</u>" is used when the noun is singular and begins with a consonant sound. "<u>AN</u>" is used when the noun is singular and beings with a vowel sound. <u>A</u>and <u>an</u> are <u>Indefinite Articles</u>.

Examples:

- 1) I can see <u>a</u> giraffe.
- 2) Golu eats <u>an</u> egg everyday.

DEFINITE ARTICLES:-

The word "<u>the</u>" is also an article. It is used before the names of buildings, rivers, seas, oceans, hills, mountains and mountain ranges. It is <u>definite article</u>.
