Some useful extra points:

- Plants makes their own food while animals cannot make their own food.
- Different animals have different eating habits and mouth parts so that they can eat their food.
- Animals that eat only plants are called herbivores.
- Eg- cows, rabbits, giraffes, horses, deers, camels, etc.
- They have sharp and broad front teeth to bite off the grass and flat back teeth which helps them to chew their food well.
- Animals that eat only the flesh of other animals are called carnivores.
- Eg- Lions, Dolphins, Owls, wolves, snakes, etc.
- They have four long, sharp and pointed teeth to tear the flesh and flat back teeth which helps them to chew their flesh.
- Animals that eat both plants and animals are called omnivores.
- Eg- Bears, crows, rats, etc.
- Snakes do not chew their food as it can swallow animals bigger than their own heads. When they have to swallow a large animal their mouth becomes big.
